Currently the Northern Humboldt Indian Education Program, Title VI Program has one full time and one part time employee and has the following grant objectives:

1. Increase Academic Achievement –Target Elementary grades

- a) Academic support (1st grade is priority).
- b) Parent Involvement – Culture/Literacy Activity nights.
- c) Local History – Target 3rd grade where local history is part of the curriculum.
- d) Professional development.

2. Decrease school dropout rate – Target High School grades.

- a) Student advocacy – follow and review grades with students, referral to support services in and outside of school district, liaison with teachers/administration and students, scholarships, summer programs and employment opportunities.
- b) Leadership – Advise Native American Club which organizes the “Success in Both Worlds” Native American Youth Conference. Students work at Inter-tribal Elders Gathering, HSU Big Time, UIHS Harvest Party, Fundraising (Indian Taco Sales), College tour.
